<p>FACILITIES:</p>	<p>Bowls Indoor is held upstairs in the Dunedin Ice Stadium, in a purpose-built hall for bowls. The location on Victoria Road is approx. 10 minute drive from the Masters Games Village. There is no lift or elevator access upstairs. Toilets are upstairs, and there are fountains to fill your drink bottle with free tap water. A heat pump is also upstairs.</p>
<p>MEDALS:</p>	<p>Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each grade. The Medal ceremony will take place at the conclusion of post section play at the venue.</p>
<p>DIRECTIONS:</p>	<p>The Dunedin Ice Stadium is located on Victoria Road, in St Kilda. There is a large, free car park available outside the venue. It is on the main St Kilda bus route, which departs from George St, just a 2 minute walk from the Games Village, every 15 minutes.</p>
<p>PROGRAMME:</p>	<p>Thursday 8 Feb: Ladies Singles 40-60, 61+ Friday 9 Feb: Mens Singles 40-60, 61+ Saturday 10 Feb: Pairs 40-60,61+ Sunday 11 Feb: Open Fours</p>
<p>FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:</p>	<p>There will be a full first aid kit available for any injuries. The Dunedin Ice Stadium also has a defibrillator on site. Please report any injuries to the Sports Coordinator on the day.</p>
<p>REFRESHMENTS:</p>	<p>Please provide your own lunch, but tea and coffee will be available. Water available. Morning and afternoon tea is provided, and is included in your entry fee.</p>
