FACILITIES:	The venue is equipped with a kitchen – tea and coffee will be provided. There are also cafes and a convenience store close to the venue as indicated on the map. Please note, the venue is upstairs, in the top floor of the building. There is no elevator.
MEDALS:	Medal ceremonies will be held at the venue at the end of each event.
DIRECTIONS:	Claymore Swords Club. Top floor. 106 Bond Street (Corner of Bond St and Police St), Dunedin. (Formerly Forno's Auction House & Gallery) Access is via the white door on the ground floor. Occasionally the white door can stick, if it feels locked, give it a 'gentle' shove. If you still cannot gain entry, ring the mobile phone doorbell.
PROGRAMME:	Saturday 10 th February: Foil – Registration 9:00am-9:15am. Fencing commences at 9:30am. Sabre – Registration 12:30pm-12:45pm. Fencing commences at 1:00pm or at the completion of the Foil. Saturday evening: Dinner – venue TBA Sunday 11 th February: Epee – Registration 9:00am-9:15am. Fencing commences at 9:30am. *Please note that if entries are insufficient to hold separate men's and women's events, then the events will be mixed.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	Masks, plastrons and clothing must be in a good state of repair and a minimum of 350nm. There is some equipment available for hire - please contact the organiser. There is a first aid kit and ice packs on site. The after hours medical centre in Hanover Street is only a few minutes away. We hope you don't need it!
REFRESHMENTS:	Tea and coffee making facilities are available at the venue. Tea/ coffee & milk are provided.
