FACILITIES:	Plenty of carparking available on site. There is no bus to take you all the way to the venue, if you require assistance with transport please contact The New Zealand Masters Games. There are toilets at the clubrooms, and large indoor clubrooms upstairs, that overlook the track. There is only wheelchair access to the ground, none to the clubrooms.
MEDALS:	The Medal Presentation will be held at the completion of the days event, outside the track or in the clubrooms depending on weather.
DIRECTIONS:	See map below. Kartsport Dunedin is approx. a 20 minute drive from the Masters Games Village.
PROGRAMME:	One event run over two days. Supplementary rules will be available early January at <a href="https://www.dnkart.org.nz">www.dnkart.org.nz</a>
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	Pre-hospital emergency care first aiders on site, as well as a first aid room and equipment. The closest medical centre is approx. 5km away in Mosgiel, and the nearest Urgent Doctors is approx. 15 minute drive, in the City Centre. Competitors must provide all their own safety equipment required as per Kartsport NZ Rules.
REFRESHMENTS:	Food and drink are available for purchase upstairs in the clubroom – hot and cold food, and drinks. No alcohol is to be consumed before or during the event, however you are able to BYO for after the event. Cash only.
