

Welcome to the 2018 NZ Masters Games

X Country Saturday 3rd Feb

We have the X Country at Mr Graeme Wallace's place approx 8km south of Allenton on SH1. It will be signposted from Allenton and plenty of pink arrows and signs into the paddock for parking.
