Toilets and change areas provided. There is a licensed bar where the presentations will be held. Stairs only into the facility.  |

| DIRECTIONS:                 | 93 Crawford Street, on the one way road heading into the city from the South. If you can find Rebel Sport and Briscoes then head North until you see McKenzie Willis on the right hand side. We are right next to them, if you get to the Car Clean business on your left you have passed us.  |
| PROGRAMME:                  | Round robin followed by Semis and Finals. Draws completed between 3-5 days out from competition, and will be published on both Metro Indoor Sports and Masters Games websites (www.nzmg.com)   |
| FIRST AID:                  | First Aid Kit on site, 5 minutes to nearest medical centre/urgent doctors.   |
| REFRESHMENTS:               | Licensed lounge on site, no BYO. Some snacks and sweets available on site, sports drinks and juice available for purchase too. Eftpos is available, sorry no credit.   |

Walking Netball, therefore, is far more strategic than regular netball! |
|                             | With two positions at each part of the court, only 6 players and nets which surround the courts, everyone is always in the game. You are able to shoot two pointers, and it doesn't matter whether you are male or female, any gender is able to play in any position.   |
|                             | Each game lasts 35 minutes, all you have to do is turn up and have a great time!   |
