

# SMALLBORE RIFLE SHOOTING - INDOOR

FACILITIES:	There is free parking available on the streets surrounding the East Otago Smallbore Rifle Association, on Victoria Road. The main entrance is up the stairs that lead from the footpath and the shooting room is accessible via internal stairs. There is no wheelchair access into the club. There are toilets inside the clubrooms.
MEDALS:	The medal ceremony will be held at the completion of the event, at each respective venue. (Ceremony for Indoor at EOSRA, Outdoor at Otago Pistol Club.)
DIRECTIONS:	The East Otago Smallbore Rifle Association is at the roundabout joining Queens Drive, Prince Albert Rd, Victoria Rd & John Wilson Drive. The entrance is directly in line with Prince Albert Road, a cream coloured building, number 61 Victoria Road.
PROGRAMME:	Squadding will commence at 2:00pm and close at 3:30pm. The competition is open to all affiliated shooters only, and will be conducted under Target Shooting NZ Rules.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	No alcohol is to be consumed before shooting. A full first aid kit is available in the clubrooms. There is ambulance access. The nearest medical centre is the Dunedin Urgent Doctors, approx. 10 minute drive.
REFRESHMENTS:	There is a bar in the clubrooms, with food, drink and alcohol available for purchase. Cash only. No alcohol is to be consumed before shooting.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION:	No alcohol is to be consumed before shooting. The course of fire will be 3x10 shot matches. Age groups 35-59, and 60+. You must have current NZ grading to apply.
INDOOR SOCIAL GRADE:	For anyone who would like to have a go at shooting. Squadding will commence at 10:30am and close at 12pm. Age group 35+. You will shoot off a rest. Course of fire 2x10 shot matches. Rifles will be supplied. There will be a charge for ammunition on the day of competition.
