FACILITIES:	To be held at Bishopscourt Grounds, Lynn Street, Dunedin and using the Kaikorai Football Rugby Clubrooms. Inside the clubrooms are changing rooms, showers and toilets as well as a warm lounge with sport available to watch on several screens. Wheelchair access to all areas. Car-parking is available on site and Marquees can be erected in the designated areas.
MEDALS:	The Medal Ceremony will be held in the clubrooms, at the conclusion of the final games on the Sunday.
DIRECTIONS:	See map below. Bishopscourt is approx. 5 a minute drive from the Masters Games Village. More directions will be provided with the Programme.
PROGRAMME:	Will be emailed to team contacts after the draw is completed. Approximately 1 week before the competition. Information will include field layout, draw and times.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	Physio and first-aid will be on site throughout the games. Strapping can be done with a small charge for this to cover the tape. Cost to be advised. Ice will be available to purchase on site if needed. All players will need to make sure they have no jewellery worn during the games and their boots adhere to the NZ Touch Rules ie no metal or screw-in studs. The referees will be checking the boots before the games.
REFRESHMENTS:	Food will be available to purchase inside the clubroom and the bar will be available during opening hours that will be advised closer to the time. Eftpos will be available.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION:	All games are played outside and will be on regardless of weather. Scoring – As per TNZ Rules each touchdown is 1 point. Officials – Will be provided for all games. Draw – Will be completed after entries close on 27 th Jan.
