

## WINE OPTIONS

FACILITIES:	Car parking is pay and display surrounding the Games Village. There are toilets accessible from the Gazebo Lounge. Lift access is available from the bottom floor to the 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor.
MEDALS:	A medal presentation will take place in the Gazebo Lounge, at the completion of the event.
DIRECTIONS:	As you enter the Games Village, the stairs ahead of you lead you up to the Gazebo Lounge. This is located on the 3rd floor, and will be signposted for Wine Options. The lift behind these stairs also takes you to the 3 <sup>rd</sup> floor.
PROGRAMME:	Wine Options is a fun event. Participants are required to enter as teams of 4. We will endeavour to put you in a team if required. Each team will need to create a name, and are encouraged to dress up.  The competition will begin at 6:30pm. Please be there promptly with your team, and ensure you check in on the night.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	A first aid kit is on site at the Village, as well as a defibrillator. Alcohol management and consumption will be monitored by our duty manager. A risk management plan will be put in place and monitored. Intoxication will not be tolerated. Free water is available at all times.
REFRESHMENTS:	Obviously, wine will be a refreshment option. Other drinks, both alcoholic and non-alcoholic will be available for purchase from downstairs in the Games Village. Snacks will be provided as part of the entry fee, but will also be available for purchase from downstairs. Cash and Eftpos is accepted.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION:	NZMG will run the event and will provide wine and snacks. The University does not allow food or drinks to be bought in from other premises.
