

VOLLEYBALL - BEACH

Date: Tuesday 6 February 2018.

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FACILITIES:	Public toilets and outdoor shower available at the beach. Brighton Beach is home to the Brighton Surf Lifesaving Club. Plenty of off-street parking next to the Surf Club Building.
MEDALS:	Medal ceremony at the end of playoffs, approx. 2pm
DIRECTIONS:	Brighton Beach is approximately 20 minutes from the University Union. Follow the one way onto the Southern Motorway, turn off at Green Island and follow the signs to Brighton. Park by the Brighton Surf Lifesaving Club and follow the path immediately opposite the club to the beach.
PROGRAMME:	The tournament will be a one-day event with round-robin play and then playoffs. Games begin at 8:30am and finish at 2pm.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	A full First Aid Kit and defibrillator are available at the Brighton Surf Lifesaving Club. The beach should be patrolled by the Brighton Surf Lifesaving Club.
REFRESHMENTS:	There is a small dairy approx. 5 minute walk from the Beach. Besides this, minimal other facilities, so please come prepared with water and food.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION:	<p>Beach Volleyball is a fun way for players of all levels to enjoy both volleyball and one of Dunedin's best beaches. Beach volleyball at the New Zealand Masters Games will have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eight categories (Four's – Mixed Social, Mixed Social Competitive, Open Male, Open Female, Open Mixed and, Pair's – Open Male, Open Female, Open Mixed) • Please note that categories may be combined if numbers require • Four's - 4 people per team on the court (max 6 team members) • Mixed teams for Social, Social Competitive and Open • The same rules as Indoor Volleyball but played on sand at Brighton Beach • A court measuring 8m x 16m (each side 8x8m which is smaller than Indoor) • A social-competitive net height • Matches will be played to 40 points or 20 minutes (whichever comes first)
