FACILITIES	Toilets and showers are available changing rooms and plenty of parking and grass areas for rigging boats
MEDALS & CEREMONIES	Medal ceremony will be held on the afternoon of the 9 th . Medals are awarded for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd in each age category.
DIRECTIONS	Time it will take to get there (10 mins) 4.8km
PROGRAMME	3 days of competition if wind is suitable. The start time for the first race is 11:30 am on the first day, racing usually goes for around 3 hours or until run out of water
FIRST AID	There will be a trained nurse out on the water on a rescue and another Pearson with a first aid certificate on shore at the club
REFRESHMENTS	There is food and drinks onsite for sale, players can BYO, there will be a function on one night.
CANCELLATIONS	All contestants will have to be at the club for a briefing before racing, they will be aware of this.
