



12KM ROAD RACE

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Start/finish is in Magnet Street opposite the Otago Yacht Club.

Magnet Street is accessed from Neptune Street which is off the large roundabout at the east end of the Forsyth Barr Stadium. Note Start is 100m from the Stadium car park via the walkway under SH88.

From the start proceed across the new Leith bridge and follow the walkway cycleway to Wickliffe Street. Cross where directed to the left hand side of Fryatt Street. Continue full length of Fryatt street and where possible keeping between the cycle lane and the edge of the road. Turn left at the end of Fryatt Street around the back of the Custom House Restaurant and cross the pathway on the wharf. Turn left into Birch Street. Continue along Birch and Kitchener Streets keeping between the cycleway and edge of road. Turn left into the reserve by the Harbour Mouth Molars and left again onto the Portsmouth Drive Walkway/cycleway. Continue on this walkway/cycleway turning left into Portobello Road and proceed to the Vauxhall to the turn around.

Return the same way where all turns will be to your right.

Please note traffic management will be in place however no roads are closed and the Walkways/Cycleway and Cycle lanes are open to all users. Please no more than two abreast.

INSTRUCTION FOR RUNNERS

Start/finish is in Magnet Street Opposite the Otago Yacht Club (course is from start/finish to Vauxhall return. See description)

- The roads are open to traffic in both directions and normal pedestrian rules apply.
- Keep to the Walkway/Cycleway where possible. Normal pedestrian/cycleway rules apply.
- Where there is no Walkway/Cycleway keep to the side of the road between the cycleway and road edge.
- Keep in Single file except when overtaking.
- The marshals are there to help but it is each runner's responsibility to take care.
- Do not use music listening devices while competing.
- There are public toilets at the wharf car park
- There is a drink station at the corner of Portsmouth Drive and Portobello Road.
