FACILITIES:	The Edgar Centre has everything you could wish for as a sportsperson at the Masters Games. Several toilet and changing facilities, as well as showers. Plenty of car parking is available at the Edgar Centre and the surrounding streets, free of charge. All areas at the Edgar Centre are wheelchair accessible. There are free filtered water taps around the venue.
MEDALS:	The Medal Ceremony will be held in the at the completion of the finals on Saturday. Medals will be presented for 1 st , 2 nd and 3 rd in each age grade for each category.
DIRECTIONS:	The Edgar Centre is approx. 10 minute drive from the Masters Games Hub. It can be accessed via Portsmouth Drive, Teviot St, or Midland St. See map for details.
PROGRAMME:	The draw will be released the week before the Games. Teams will play 2 or 3 games a day. Each game will be 2x 25 minute halves, with 3 minutes for half time. Pool games are 3 for a win, 1 for a loss, 2 for a draw.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	The Sports Injury Clinic will be running from inside the Edgar Centre. The Doctors here can provide medical assistance, as well as referring for further treatments. Strapping can be done here too for a small charge.
REFRESHMENTS:	Food and drinks will be available for purchase, at the café onsite. Alcohol is also available for purchase from the Edgar Centre. Their licence does not allow alcohol to be bought in from outside the premises.
