AGE GROUPS:	Advertised as 35 – 39; 40 - 44; 45 – 49; 50 – 54; 55 -59 & 60+ but will be dependent on entries. No mixed grades
FORMAT:	 Draws of eight or round-robins of four. One match per day. PAR scoring to 15 - win by 2. Ball - Official ball will be Dunlop single yellow dot. Double yellow and blue dot by agreement All players are required to mark/referee straight after they play All disputes will be addressed by tournament controller. Decision final. Where both players are on SNZ grading list, points will be processed for grading points Appropriate standard of clothing must be worn. Tournament information booklet will be provided to all players
