PROGRAMME:	Every days matches START AT 9a.m. Events as per entry guide.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	The Sports Injury Clinic will be running from inside the Edgar Centre. The Doctors here can provide medical assistance, as well as referring for further treatments. Strapping can be done here too for a small charge.
REFRESHMENTS:	Food and drinks will be available for purchase. Alcohol is also available for purchase from the Edgar Centre. Their licence does not allow alcohol to be bought in from outside the premises.
