

# CURLING

FACILITIES:	Curling is held in the Dunedin Ice Stadium approx. 10 minute drive from the Games Hub. The Ice Rink is on the ground floor accessible for everyone. There are toilets and changing rooms available downstairs and on the first floor with a lift to access the upstairs lounge, bar and facilities. The upstairs lounge will be open for spectators to view the action.
MEDALS:	A medal ceremony will take place at the end of competition. Medals will be present to each section of the tournament.
DIRECTIONS:	The Dunedin Ice Stadium is located on 101 Victoria Road, in St Kilda. There is a large, free car park available outside the venue. It is on the main St Kilda bus routes, Numbers 44 and 55. Busses depart from the Bus Hub in Great King Street, only a short walk from the Games Hub
PROGRAMME:	The tournament will be divided into sections. The number of teams in each section will be dependent on the number of teams entered. Each section will play a round robin tournament. 16 teams can play at any one time. Curling will commence at 8.30 am each day.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	There will be a full regulation first aid kit available for any injuries. There is a first aid room, with 2 beds if necessary.  The Dunedin Ice Stadium also has a defibrillator on site. Please report any injuries to the Sports Coordinator on the day.
REFRESHMENTS:	A licenced bar will be operating during the tournament, where food and drink will be available. Cash ONLY. Lunchs, morning and afternoon teas for both days are included in the ice fee of \$110 payable to the Stadium. EFTPOS (not credit card) is available for payment.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION:	Officials will be provided. Rules have been adjusted for Masters. The Tournament is Crampit Curling Only – sliding is not permitted. Stones and Brooms are provided. , Galoshes and Helmets are available free of charge if required.
