<b>MEDALS:</b>	<p>Medals will be presented at prizegiving, immediately following the final games.</p>
<b>DIRECTIONS:</b>	<p>The South Dunedin Community Hall is across the road from Heff Hotel on King Edward Street, South Dunedin. This is approximately a 10 minute drive from the Games Hub.</p> <p>There are bus stops along King Edward St, South Dunedin near the Community Hall.</p>
<b>PROGRAMME:</b>	<p>All players need to bring their own darts with them.</p> <p>Pool play, followed by knockout rounds before playoffs (depending on numbers)</p>
