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FACILITIES:	Clubrooms are available at the venue where toilets including mobility are open. Kitchen facilities including microwave, oven available to competitors. Please see organisers to use these.
MEDALS:	A medal ceremony will take place at the end of competition. Medals will be presented to each section of the tournament.
DIRECTIONS:	Dunedin City Petanque Club is located at 80 Eglinton Road, Mornington next to the Zingari Rugby fields. The venue will be well signed with flags. Carparking is available in the club and on street side.
PROGRAMME:	Singles will be divided into 5 sections. Doubles will be divided into 2 sections. Singles and doubles will alternate rounds Games will be timed to a limit
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	There will be a full regulation first aid kit available for any injuries and trained first aiders will be at the venue at all times. Please see organisers should you require medical assistance. You are required to fill out an Accident Report form.
