FACILITIES	The 4 court Badminton Hall contains toilets and showers. There is lots of parking available nearby.
MEDALS & CEREMONIES	Gold, silver and bronze medals are awarded in each event. Medals will be presented onsite at the conclusion of each event.
DIRECTIONS	The badminton venue is in Springvale Park and is around a 5 minutes drive from the Games Village.
PROGRAMME	Saturday: Mixed Doubles. 35+ and 55+ age groups start at 9am. 45+ and 65+ start not before 1pm.  Sunday: Men's and Women's Doubles. 35+ and 55+ age groups start at 9am. 45- and 65+ start not before 1pm.  Monday: Men's and Women's Singles. 35+ and 55+ start at 9am. 45+ and 65+ start not before 11am.  Social Doubles. Men and Women's Doubles start at 9am.  Tuesday/Wednesday: Teams events. 35+, 55+ and Social Teams start at 9am both days.
FIRST AID	First Aid (including a Defibrillator) is available onsite. The hospital is around a 3 minute drive.
REFRESHMENTS	Tea and coffee will be available during the event.
SPORT SPECIFIC INFORMATION	Players may enter an event up to the night before that event (the appropriate sports fee will need to be paid).  A list of entries for each event will be posted at the Hall and on the Badminton Whanganui website.  All matches will be the best of 3 games to 15 points (extension to 20).  Round-robin format will be used in all events with post-section play where there are 2 or more pools.  Rules of play for both pool and post-section play will be displayed at the venue.  (Standard BWF rules apply).  RSL Supreme feather shuttles (if sufficient supply) will be used for all events.  Teams without full membership will be put together by Monday afternoon.
