<b>FACILITIES</b>	<i>The Clubrooms have toilets, showers and changing room facilities along with cash bar (no eft-pos), Boat Wash and Fish Filleting station available. If the Clubrooms are locked or unmanned, then there is a public toilet located within the boat trailer parking area directly opposite the boat ramp on Wharf St.</i>
<b>MEDALS &amp; CEREMONIES</b>	<i>Medal Ceremony will be held at the clubrooms, 1 Wharf St on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021 at 5:30pm</i>
<b>DIRECTIONS</b>	<i>The Clubrooms and boat ramp are located in Wharf St, Wanganui. There is ample free car &amp; trailer parking across the road from the boat ramp. Boat ramp launching and retrieval is also free.</i>
<b>PROGRAMME</b>	<i>Fishing hours are from 6am to 4pm on Mon 8<sup>th</sup> Feb - Fri 12<sup>th</sup> Feb 2021. Anglers may fish any or all days during the competition. There will be no postponement or cancellation due to weather. It is the angler's sole responsibility to decide if the conditions are safe for fishing or not. Please see competition rules for full details.</i>
<b>FIRST AID &amp; SAFETY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- All boats should carry the recommended safety equipment which includes but is not limited to VHF radio, cell phone, first aid kit, flares, EPIRB, life jackets (per person), anchor &amp; warp, bilge pump, bucket, compass, knife, fire extinguisher, tools, torch</li> <li>- It is the Captains responsibility to ensure that all crew wear life jackets when travelling and all crew are in a fit state to be at sea.</li> <li>- Coastguard Radio: Wanganui Coastguard Radio is operated on VHF Chanel 64 and you must lodge a trip report with them. Please remember to "close" out your trip report upon your return. If you do not have a VHF then you can also file a trip report by phoning Coastguard on 06 344 4686</li> <li>- Shore based anglers should carry the appropriate safety gear applicable to the conditions and the location being fished and with any water-based activity it is advised that you tell someone of your plans and expected return time.</li> </ul>

Existing members have 24/7 access via electronic key fob.</i>
