<b>FACILITIES:</b>	The Edgar Centre has everything you could wish for as a sports person at the Masters Games. Several toilets and changing facilities, as well as showers. Plenty of car parking is available at the Edgar Centre and the surrounding streets, free of charge. All areas at the Edgar Centre are wheelchair accessible. There are free filtered water taps around the venue.
<b>MEDALS:</b>	The Medal Ceremony will be held at the completion of the finals on Friday. Medals will be presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each age grade for each category.
<b>DIRECTIONS:</b>	The Edgar Centre is approx. 10 minute drive from the Masters Games Hub. It can be accessed via Portsmouth Drive, Teviot St, or Midland St.
<b>PROGRAMME:</b>	The draw will be released the week before the Games. Teams will play up to 2 games a day. Each game will be 2x 25 minute halves, with 3 minutes for half time with last 2 minutes being stop clock in close games. Pool games are 3 for a win, 1 for a loss, 2 for a draw. All FIBA rules unless stated.
<b>FIRST AID &amp; SAFETY EQUIPMENT:</b>	The Sport Injury Clinic will be running from the Sargood Centre, Logan Park drive during games week. Medics will also be present at event. Please see organiser should you require medical attention. Strapping will be available from the Sargood Centre; Logan Park drive at a small cost.
<b>REFRESHMENTS:</b>	Food and drinks will be available for purchase, at the café onsite. Alcohol is also available for purchase from the Edgar Centre. Their licence does not allow alcohol to be bought in from outside the premises.
