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FACILITIES:	The venue is equipped with a kitchen – tea and coffee will be provided. There are also cafes and a convenience store close to the venue as indicated on the map. Please note, the venue is upstairs, in the top floor of the building. There is no elevator.
MEDALS:	Medal ceremonies will be held at the venue at the end of each event.
DIRECTIONS:	Claymore Swords Club. Top floor. 106 Bond Street (Corner of Bond St and Police St), Dunedin. (Formerly Forno's Auction House & Gallery) Access is via the white door on the ground floor.
PROGRAMME:	Saturday 12 <sup>th</sup> February:  Foil – Registration 9:00am-9:15am. Fencing commences at 9:30am.  Sabre – Registration 12:30pm-12:45pm. Fencing commences at 1:00pm or at the completion of the Foil.  Saturday evening: Dinner – venue TBA  Sunday 13 <sup>th</sup> February:  Epee – Registration 9:00am-9:15am. Fencing commences at 9:30am.  *Please note that if entries are insufficient to hold separate men's and women's events, then the events will be mixed.
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	Masks, plastrons and clothing must be in a good state of repair. Minimum of 1150N protection for Torso. This can be made up either by 350N Jacket with an 800N plastron, or 800N Jacket with a 350N plastron. 350N breeches. 350N Mask. All masks must be fitted well and in good state and elastic in good condition. Leon Paul X-Change Masks must have a secondary Strap/Bar. Lame bibs are required for foil.  There is some equipment available for hire - please contact the organiser.  There is a first aid kit and ice packs on site. The after-hours medical centre in Filleul Street is only a few minutes away. We hope you don't need it!
