



**Date:** Saturday 12 and Sunday 13 February

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<b>FACILITIES:</b>	The venue is equipped with a kitchen – tea and coffee will be provided. There are also cafes and a convenience store close to the venue as indicated on the map. Please note, the venue is upstairs, in the top floor of the building. There is no elevator.
<b>MEDALS:</b>	Medal ceremonies will be held at the venue at the end of each event.
<b>DIRECTIONS:</b>	Claymore Swords Club. Top floor. 106 Bond Street (Corner of Bond St and Police St), Dunedin. (Formerly Forno's Auction House & Gallery) Access is via the white door on the ground floor.

Fencing commences at 9:30am.  *Please note that if entries are insufficient to hold separate men's and women's events, then the events will be mixed.</p>
<b>FIRST AID &amp; SAFETY EQUIPMENT:</b>	Masks, plastrons and clothing must be in a good state of repair. Minimum of 1150N protection for Torso. This can be made up either by 350N Jacket with an 800N plastron, or 800N Jacket with a 350N plastron. 350N breeches. 350N Mask. All masks must be fitted well and in good state and elastic in good condition. Leon Paul X-Change Masks must have a secondary Strap/Bar. Lamé bibs are required for foil. There is some equipment available for hire - please contact the organiser. There is a first aid kit and ice packs on site. The after-hours medical centre in Filleul Street is only a few minutes away. We hope you don't need it!
<b>REFRESHMENTS:</b>	Tea and coffee making facilities are available at the venue. Tea/ coffee & milk are provided.
