FACILITIES:	Practice ranges and putting greens are available at each course. Any golfer wanting to play prior to the games may do so. Green Fees will apply. Bookings may be made with the professionals at each club. Each club has a bar and clubrooms, changing facilities, toilets, and plenty of carparking.
MEDALS:	A Medal Ceremony will be held in the clubhouse at each course at the completion of each event.
DIRECTIONS:	All 4 courses are within 10 minutes of the city and the Games Hub. Buses run very close to each course, all departing from various locations a 10 minute walk from the Games Hub.
PROGRAMME:	The rules of golf apply to all events and can be found at www.golf.co.nz. A copy of the draw will be released around 30 January, on the Masters Games Website www.nzmg.com
FIRST AID & SAFETY EQUIPMENT:	Each course has a full first aid kit, and defibrillator on site. Please report any injuries to the Sports Coordinator on the day. The closest medical centre to all 3 courses is the Dunedin Urgent Doctors, 2 minute drive from the Masters Games Hub.
REFRESHMENTS:	Food and drinks are available in the clubhouse and the pro shops. A bar is available and will be open at all courses, accepting Cash and EFTPOS.

The Stableford event is included for those who are unable to commit to the two day championship.
