WELCOME TO THE GAMES

The Otago Community Trust New Zealand Masters Games are back and they're bigger than ever!

The 35th annual Masters Games will be held in Ōtepoti Dunedin from February 3-11. Over nine days and nights, an estimated 5,000+ people from around New Zealand, Australia, and the globe will come together to enjoy Aotearoa's largest annual multi-sport event. Will you be one of them?

This will be the 16th year Dunedin hosts the Games and we look forward to welcoming back familiar faces and introducing newcomers to everything the event has to offer. You don't need to be an elite athlete to enter – the goal of the Games is to encourage participation in sport, no matter a person's age or ability. While some participants aim for a place on the podium or to improve their personal best, for others it's an opportunity to catch up with friends and enjoy the social side of things.

Medals are awarded in each sport, in different age categories and, in some cases, both social and competitive grades, so go for gold – or just compete for fun. Whatever your reason, make sure you're part of the action in 2024!

What Makes A Master?

At the Masters Games we have participants ranging in age from 18-years old to 95 and beyond. Each sport has a different minimum age at which someone is considered a master and it might be younger than you think!

For example, did you know that in Swimming you're a master at 20 and for Ice Figure Skating it's just 18. In most sports you're a Master by the time you turn 30, so make sure to check out your sport to see if you're eligible.

Sports for Everyone

With more than 60 sports on offer – and more than 300 separate events – there are loads of activities to choose from. From running to jumping, kicking to shooting, we have it covered. And in 2024 we're introducing three new events: Pickleball, Jigsaw Racing and Cowboy Action Shooting. Yeehar!

Whether you're an experienced athlete, returning to a previously loved sport or an enthusiastic beginner – we know you'll find your place at the Masters Games.

The Hub of the Games

The Masters Games is as much about the social events as it is about the sports and in 2024 we're going old school, with our Games Hub returning to everyone's favourite, the University Union.

Throughout the Games the Hub will play host to some sports and medal ceremonies. And, of course, there'll be day and night action,

making this as much fun for spectators as Masters.

Partygoers can head to the Hub each evening to check out the top entertainment, take to the dance floor or catch up with mates. With an amazing line-up of entertainment throughout the week, each night is an event in its own right!

Fun Events

As well as traditional sports we have several Fun Events on the schedule. If you think you can tell a Sauvignon Blanc from a Pinot Gris, want to have a go at Petanque, or try your hand at a lesser-known sport such as Cornhole – add a Fun Event to your entry.

Fun Events give you the opportunity to try new sports, test out different skills and they're great social occasions to compete with (or against!) your friends. While medals are still hotly contested, the fun factor is what matters most in these events.

In 2024 we have several Para Masters grades in some of the existing sports events. These events offer athletes that have an impairment the option to compete in the Masters Games in a Para division. Sports on offer include Archery, Athletics - Track and Field, Petanque, Cornhole, Darts, Power Lifting, Indoor Rowing, Swimming and Indoor Triathlon.

How to Enter

Entries are now open for the 2024 Otago Community Trust New Zealand Masters Games and we encourage you to complete your entry early to qualify for a discount. The simplest and easiest way to enter is online.

Enter at nzmg.com/enter-now

- 1. Select your entry type
- 2. Add your details, and sports (if competing)
- 3. Complete payment
- 4. Receive an instant confirmation

If you are unable to enter online, you can contact the Masters Games office on 0800 303 500 during office hours and complete the entry and payment over the phone.

NOTE: To enter Team Sports the Team Manager must first set up the team before players can enter.

Entry Fee Options

There are two components to the Masters Games entry fee:

1. COMPETITOR ENTRY FEE

This enables you to enter the Games as a competitor. The fees are:

\$70.00 Early Bird Entry before 30 November 2023

\$100.00 Standard Entry between 1 December 2023 and 11 January 2024

\$130.00 Final Entry from 12 January 2024

2. SPORT FEE

The sport fee enables you to compete in specific sports of the Games and varies depending on which sport or sports you enter. You can refer to the individual sports to see the fee that applies.

SUPPORTERS FEE

If you'd like to be part of the Games but not compete in a sports event, you have the option to enter as a Supporter. For \$45 you receive all the entry fee inclusions of a competitor, with the exception of being able to compete in any Masters Games sports or win medals.

2. Fitness to Enter

You are in sound physical condition and health, and capable of competing in the number and type of events for which you have entered, and for those which you may yet enter in the 2024 New Zealand Masters Games (NZMG).

3. Injury Procedures

In the event that you sustain an injury or illness whilst participating in NZMG, you authorise the appointed sports injury personnel to perform and administer such emergency medical attention as they think is necessary. You understand that as a participant, you have no additional sports injury insurance or coverage provided by organisers.

4. Accidents

You understand that NZMG is in no way responsible for compensation for any injury received, or for any personal expenditure made as the result of any accident during your participation in any event or activity.

5. Rules

You must abide by the rules and regulations as set down by the sports body organising the event in which you have entered (The Sport).
